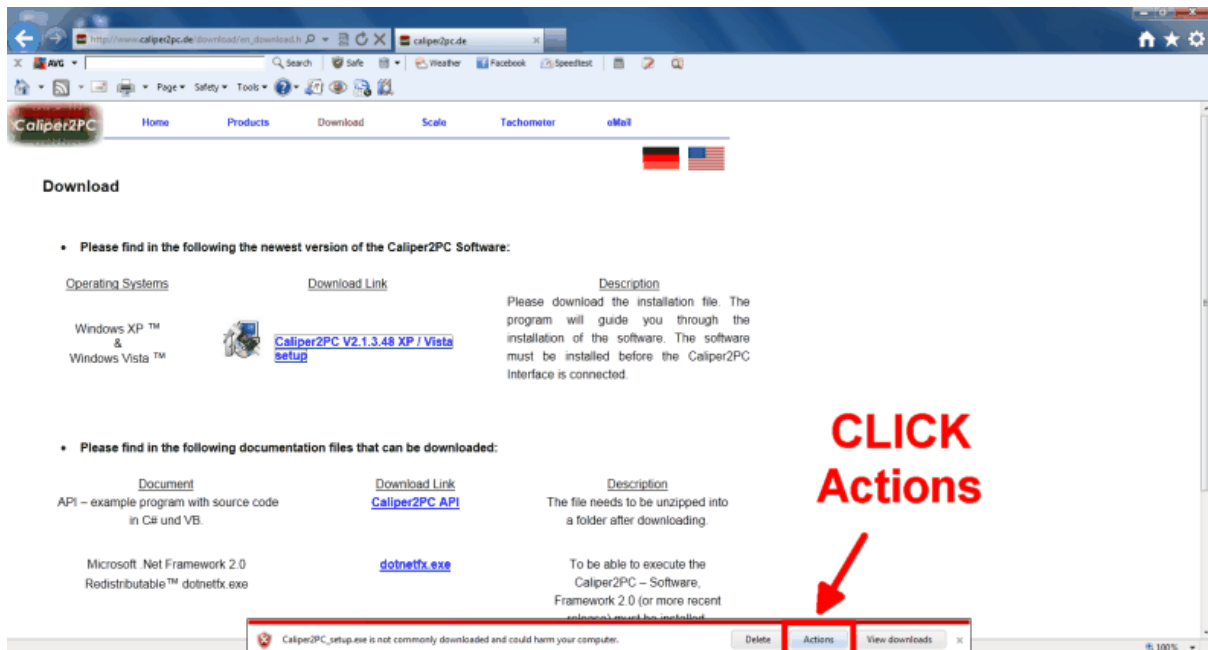


# Running the Caliper2PC Software under Window 7

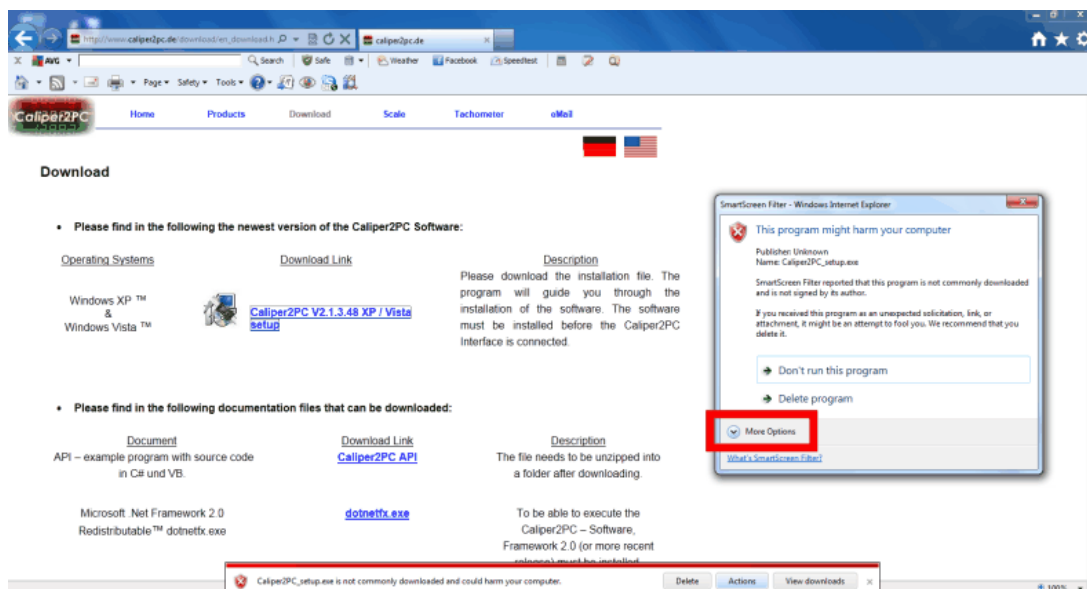


When downloading the Caliper2PC software the following message pops up:

*“Caliper2PC\_setup.exe is not commonly downloaded and could harm your Computer.”*



Click on the “Actions” button.



Open the drop-down menu by clicking the “More Options” button. Choose the “Run anyway” option and install the Caliper2PC software.
